The MultiDiagnostic is easy-to-use, consisting of a test strip and a suite of software. Clinicians will determine test results in 20 minutes or less and avoid the costs, time, and risks associated with sending samples to an off-

site laboratory. Obtaining quantitative, evidence-based results at the point of care enables clinicians to develop more informed care plans, improving overall quality of care.

In addition to Group K's image processing algorithm, the software suite includes a number of valuable features, such as epidemic tracking, inter-hospital record keeping, and a patient portal.
